The children seem to have really enjoyed the various STEM challenges they have been working on this week. Tuesday afternoon's marble run challenge was particularly good fun and led to some fascinating scientific thinking and conversations. The children will be sharing the videos in assembly later today. I have seen some fantastic science work from the children – and have learned some new facts myself!

This morning was reward time for the children for the excellent behaviour choices almost everyone has made over the past half term. I am delighted to share with you that 92% of the children have received a gold certificate and a further 3% have attained a silver certificate. Very few children have made choices which have meant that they do not receive a certificate today. You may also be interested to know that an education visitor to our school commented specifically on the outstanding level of independent behaviour shown by the children, their collaborative working practices and their politeness.

Following a suggestion from the Representative Parent Group, the PTA are offering a uniform ordering window for parents whose children are currently in our school. In this newsletter you will find a uniform order form. Should you wish to order any new items for your child ready for the new academic year in September, please do so by Friday 22nd June. Any items not ordered by this deadline will not be available for the start of the Autumn term. The ordered uniform will be available for collection on Wednesday 18th July. Please note this date in your diary – Mrs Holder will have the items ready for you to collect at the end of the school day from the playground/hall. We hope that you will find this arrangement helpful.
