REPORTING TO PARENTS

Communication with parents is a key part of our support for the children's learning. All parents sign the Home School Agreement, which outlines their role in this shared responsibility. This is done when their child enters the school and at the start of KS2.

At the start of each academic year parents of children in Y1 to Y6 are invited to a 'Meet the Teacher' meeting. YR parents are invited to a tea towards the end of September; and to any Friday morning ½ hour shared learning session. All parents are invited to attend a consultation meeting once during autumn term and again in the spring term. Graphs showing their child's progress in English, Mathematics and Science are sent home following the assessment weeks in the autumn and spring terms. At the end of the academic year a written report covering all areas of the curriculum is sent home.
