At the end of their time with us 93% of children attained L4+ and 59% L5+ in reading; 74% L4+ and 52% L5+ in SPAG; and 78% L4+ and 48% L5+ in mathematics. This represents 93% of children making or exceeding expected progress in reading, 100% writing and 93% in mathematics.
