At the end of their time with us 100% of children attained L4+ and 84% L5+ in reading; 84% L4+ and 64% L5+ in SPAG; and 100% L4+ and 60% L5+ in mathematics. This represents 100% of children making or exceeding expected progress in reading, writing and mathematics.
