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#### **Head Teacher's Remarks**

Working together to achieve our potential

Dear Parents,

In relation to school discos, the PTA would like to introduce new protocols for these events to ensure a safe and enjoyable evening for all.

- 1) Children will no longer be able to walk home from the discos on their own.
- 2) The following information will need to be recorded on the 'disco form' you complete (the one found in the newsletter near disco time):

If you are taking/collecting others people's children.

If there are any 'triggers that the PTA need to be aware of in relation to your child/ren', and how to respond to these.

If your child/ren have any medical problems, please advise the PTA and the school staff. (Although all school staff are First Aid trained, medication can only be administered by very few adults in the school who have received further training. This is Health and Safety legislation.)

For general safety a telephone number will need to be put on your disco form in case you need to be contacted.

- 3) Children are expected to behave well, no climbing on gym equipment or other items. Any bad behaviour may result in a phone call home.
- 4) At the end of each disco, the children will be put into year groups in the hall. As parents arrive they will be directed to find their child/ren and they can then be signed out.
- 5) Please make children aware that music can be loud. It is fine to take some fresh air but only for a few moments just outside the doors in view of an adult.

Please note, the discos will now have the following new timings:

5.15-6.15 for KS1

6.30-7.30 for KS2
