Head Teacher's Remarks

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Welcome back to the start of an exciting school year -I do hope you all enjoyed some time with the children over the summer and were able to make the most of the pleasant spells of weather. The children have started the term refreshed and raring to go, and are really enjoying the various activities of Good to be Us Week. As usual this is a full and exciting special timetable, which I am sure the children will share with you.

Please remember the Meet the Teacher sessions at 2:45pm: for Y6 today, Y1 on Monday, Y5 on Tuesday, Y4 on Wednesday, Y2 on Thursday and Y3 next Friday. I am sure you will find the time informative.

As usual at the start of the year we are including with this communication the updated quick reference guide which I hope you will find helpful as a reminder of our policies. Please do remember the break-time snacks policy. In light of the Government requirement for schools to encourage and educate children in healthy life choices, and following decisions by the School Council, break-time snacks must be fresh or plain dried fruit or vegetables only on Monday to Thursday. All KS1 children have access to this as part of the 'Fruit for Schools' scheme. On a Friday other snacks are permitted, but please not too unhealthy! Problems of children's diets continue to be a feature of press coverage, and we are held to account for the way we encourage the children to learn good life choices.

May I also remind you that all items of clothing should be clearly named. Mislaid property is put out in the playground on a Friday afternoon weather permitting. Thank you.

A calendar of key dates accompanies this newsletter. As more dates are confirmed I will include them in future newsletters for you to add to your version. Next week we will send out a grid of possible visits and visitors for the coming year, which will almost certainly have further additions and amendments. Please remember that each year group will probably have at least one visit or a visitor each term. We request a voluntary termly contribution of £10 per child to assist towards the cost of the visitors who come into school and the additional opportunities we offer to the children through the Curriculum Enrichment programme weekly. This should be paid electronically. We thank you for your support with this as it really enhances the learning opportunities for the children. Do remember that you can also support the school through the Governors Development Fund and the work of the PTA. Information for these is on Joinos for your convenience.

Information about the lunch-time and after school clubs, most of which will be starting week commencing 18th September, will be sent out on Tuesday. Please complete and return the reply slip by the requested deadline expressing interest in the clubs – any payments will be invoiced to you once allocations have been made.

As you may have already noticed, our new fitness equipment in the playground was installed prior to the start of term. Please could I ask that you ensure that younger siblings do not play by this equipment whilst waiting for their elder brothers or sisters. This is for Health and Safety and insurance reasons. Our children are being taught to use the equipment safely and know that they should not be on it after school. Thank you for your help with this.

Each family will receive a hard copy letter this evening regarding new procedures. Please do note the contents, and should you need to discuss these do contact us next week. Thank you in advance for your co-operation with them.

Finally I am sure you will be pleased to know that Mrs Beach's operation was successful. She is now in her recovery period, and misses being with us all. In the immediate future whilst we are awaiting her return, Mrs Hughes and Mrs McLeman are teaching Y1 from Mrs Beach's planning. The class are settled and learning well already.
