Head Teacher's Remarks

We have had a very busy week in school as the children are keenly getting Next Week's Reminders into their new topics. Year 3 enjoyed a most interesting visit to the Ashmoleon Museum on Wednesday, and learned all sorts of facts about Ancient Egypt. Some of our KS2 children attended a dance workshop prior to taking part in a festival later this term – they will now be working on developing their performance. Good luck everyone.

> The children are looking forward to all the clubs starting next week (although choir and Rock School started yesterday!). I am sure they will enjoy their activities. If your child was disappointed that the club they hoped for was full, please be assured that we do hold waiting lists, so hopefully they will have a further opportunity.

> As the winter weather seems to be with us, please could I remind parents that boots/wellies are fine for coming to school and for going home, but are not suitable for class time. The children should bring their school shoes to put on during the day, as is recommended for the good of their feet. Thank you for your help with this.

> Attendance during the winter months can be difficult due to colds and other 'bugs'. If your child is unwell and so unable to attend, please could you phone the office by 8:30am on the first day of absence. A written note explaining the absence should be brought in when your child returns to school. If their period of illness is over a weekend and they are still unwell on Monday morning, please could you phone to confirm this. Thank you in advance for your support with this – I am sure you will appreciate how important it is that we can account for all the children!

> Late arriving is an increasing problem, which causes an upset to the start of the learning, both for the late child and the rest of the class. Whilst we do appreciate that there are times when the traffic can be a problem, please could everyone make a particular effort to ensure the children arrive prior to 8:35am. Should the gates be shut, the children must come in through the main entrance, reporting to a member of the office staff so that we know the children have arrived on site. From Monday, a late book will be required to be completed to explain their late arrival. (Should your child travel on the school coach and it is delayed, then they should come in through the main entrance as usual. No written explanation will be required in those circumstances.)

> Our half term target this half term is aspiration. We are encouraging the children to think about what they aspire to, and how they might make those dreams come true by developing skills and attitudes as a start point. (Even professional footballers need to tie shoe-laces!) In our assemblies this term we will be focussing on our values and how we can demonstrate them to be fantastic young people. Do ask your children about these – on Monday we looked at honesty.
