A reminder - Yellow Zigzag Lines

- **Location:** Typically found at the entrances and exits of schools, hospitals, police stations, and ambulance stations.
 - **Meaning:** Motorists are not permitted to stop, wait, or park their vehicles in these areas at any time, unless there is an accompanying sign specifying different restrictions.
 - **Purpose:** To keep these important access points clear for emergency vehicles and ensure the safety of pedestrians, especially children around schools.
