*Thanks as always for your support. See you there!*

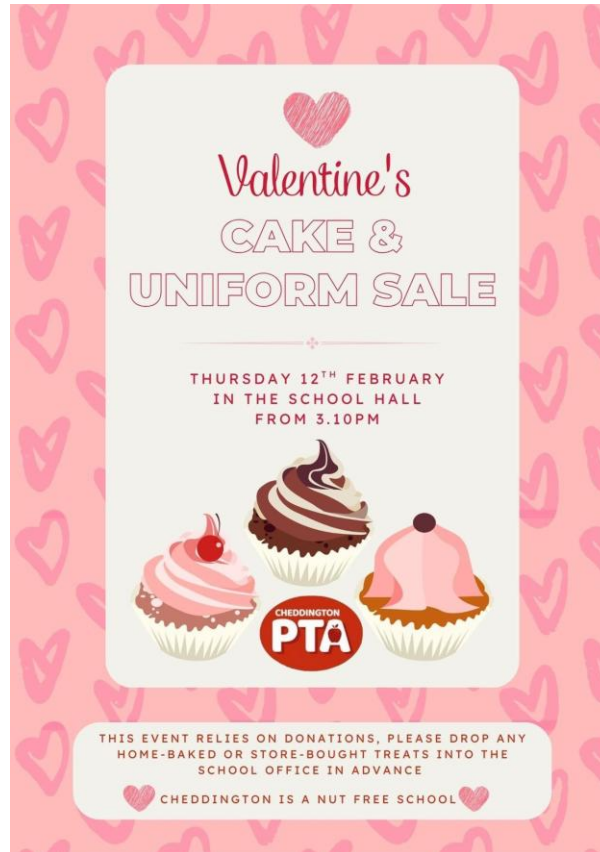

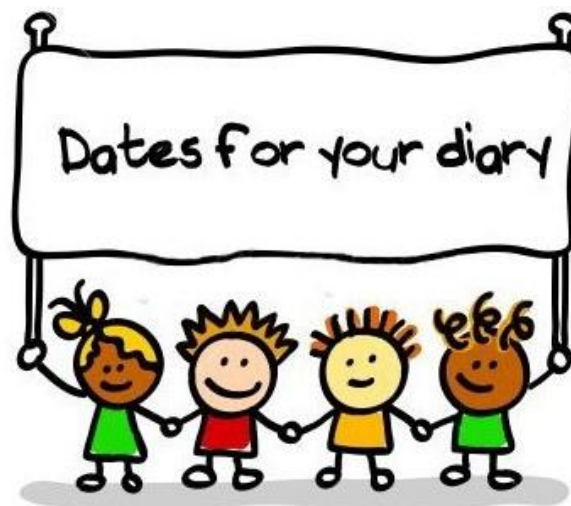
