This week has been dominated by heat, and KS2 rehearsals! We are all looking forward to the dress rehearsal this afternoon – it is sounding wonderful. All classes have been enjoying their learning, and a number of children have shown me their lovely work. It is always a pleasure to share in their successes. Over recent weeks the teachers have completed the end of year written reports which will come home with your children this afternoon. We hope you will find them informative; and we would be grateful if you could return the reply slip promptly, as that is our proof that your child has given the report to you! (KS2 results will be sent home next week as they are not yet published by the Department for Education.)

As a school we are always conscious of the costs for parents in supporting their children's learning, and are appreciative of that support. In these times of cuts to school budgets we all need to encourage the children to treat their resources sensibly. We are also keen to develop life skills in the older children. Therefore we are offering a stationery shop from September, which will be run by Y6 children. We do understand that to choose your pencil case is a very important part of school life – especially that first one in Y2. However the contents we can offer at a much reduced rate than commercial suppliers.
