Y1 were fascinated by a visit from Talking Talons, who brought a number of animals into the classroom to enhance the science curriculum. Parents or Guardians are responsible for ensuring their children's safety to and from school, even when a School Crossing Patroller is provided, just as they would do when a zebra or pelican crossing is provided. STOP behind the Patroller WAIT until told to cross WALK across the road in front of the Patroller Safely to School.
